SHUTTLE SERVICE AND TRANSPORTATION

Showgrounds are at walking distance from Hotel Oru, so there is no shuttle service provided by the Organizer. For transportation, if needed, please call a Tulika Taxi +372 6 120 000, at the expense of athletes.

ENTRY TO THE SHOW VENUE

Entrance bracelets will be distributed as follows:

1 bracelet to the athlete

1 bracelets to the groom (2 grooms per athlete)

1 bracelet to the partner

2 bracelets to the horse owner(s) according to accreditations in the FEI-Passport

Only persons with bracelets are allowed to enter the showground, stables and festival area.

ARRIVAL AND ACCOMMODATION OF HORSES

Horses are accommodated at the expense of the OC from Thursday to Sunday

Stables are open: 05:30 until 23.00.

Stabling includes initial bedding (shavings). Unfortunately, there is no straw provided.

The sale of hay and shavings will be carried out from trailers in the middle of the stable area, at **8:00-9:00, 14:00-15:00 and 20:00-21:00**

Shavings - 10 EUR per bag

Hay - 5 EUR per square bale

Electricity requests also need to be done with FEI entries.

Payment at the Show Office at the time of settling the accounts.

In order to facilitate the arrival of horses, the time and date and the means of transport must be sent to Stable Manager **Maris Kartau** at maris.kartau@gmail.com

PLEASE NOTE:

- All manure must be dropped in the designated area at the stables.
- It's forbidden to smoke in the stables or bring alcoholic beverages to the stable area.
- All dogs must be kept on a leash!

If violations are stated by the stable manager, the OC can demand a fine up to € 100 per offence.

HORSE INSPECTION

Horse inspection of CSI will be carried out on the warmup arena on **THURSDAY**, 31.08.2017 at **16:30-18:00**.

Please remember to bring your horse's passport to the show office in good time BEFORE the horse inspection.

Competing horses must wear their bridle numbers at all times outside the stable.

BANDAGE AND TACK CONTROL DURING FEI EVENTS

The control of boots, bandages or tack material for possible welfare issues, the presence of foreign bodies and/or application of irritating or prohibited substances may be carried out by Stewards during a class or an exercise/schooling period.

For all international Young Horse competitions (six and seven year old horses): All hind leg protections must have a maximum interior length of 16 cm; the width of the fastener must be at least 5cm.

Please be prepared, Stewards can ask your horse for a bandage and tack control!

ENTRIES & SCHOOLING SCHEDULE

Please make your entries for the next day before 18:00 in the Show Office.

The draws are done by computer at the JUDGES TOWER.

Show ground is open for schooling as follows:

Thursday, 31.08.2017: Jumpers 13.00-15.30

Training is possible together with dressage riders in the warmup/training ring as follows:

Thursday, 31.08 11:00-15:30 + 1 hour after last competition *All riders together*

Friday, 1.09 06:30-07:30 + 1 hour after last competition *All riders together*

Saturday, 2.09 06:30-07:30 + 1 hour after last competition

Sunday, 3.09 06:30-07:30 + 1 hour after last competition

AWARDS CEREMONY & PRIZE MONEY

Awards ceremonies are held right after the completion of each class.

The owner of the winning **horse is invited** to the prize giving ceremony for the Grand Prix.

The number of athletes required to present themselves for the prize-giving ceremony of each competition is **six**. All prize money will be paid at the Cashier's Office together with settling of the accounts. Twenty-five percent of participants per competition receive prize Money.

CASHIER INFO AND SETTLING OF THE ACCOUNTS

Settling of the accounts will be done at the Cashier's Office after the end of the last competition class, on Sunday 03.09.

The fees and charges for CSI2*-W/CSIU25-A/CSIYH1* are as follows:

Entry fee CSI2*-W	350 EUR per horse
Entry fee CSIYH1*	250 EUR per horse
Entry fee CSIU25-A	250 EUR per horse
EADCMP fee for CSIYH1*	18 EUR per horse
EADCMP fee for all the rest	25 EUR per horse
Electricity for lorries and caravans	40 EUR, upon request
Hay	5 EUR per bale
Shavings	10 EUR per bag
Manure disposal fee	40 EUR per horse

THE CASHIER'S OFFICE IS OPEN:

Thursday, 31.08	16:00 - 30 min after the last competition
Friday, 01.09	10:00 - 30 min after the last competition
Saturday, 02.09	10:00 - 30 min after the last competition
Sunday, 03.09	08.00 - 1 hour after the last competition

All prize money will be paid at the time of settling the accounts. Tax will be deducted 20%.
After settling the accounts, the horse passports will be returned at the Show Office against the receipt of full payment.

MISCELLANEOUS INFO

SMOKING IS FORBIDDEN in the stables and other areas of the showgrounds!

It is only allowed in the designated smoking areas.

The dogs have to be always kept on the leash!

At Lauluväljak territory the silent hours are from 11 p.m until 7 a.m. In case of violating the silent hours the fee is 1000€ and it should be paid to organizer at Cashier's Office while setting the accounts.
